

OAK PARK POOL

Party Rental Pricing and Policy (*revised April 2019*)

- Prices reflect hourly costs to host a party, minimum party duration is 2 hrs.
- A 50% deposit is required to reserve the date.
- The pool does not host parties for non-member adults (*more information provided below*)

Child Parties (majority of swimmers ≤ 15 years-of-age)

Attendants	Monday to Thursday	Friday, to Sunday
15 or less swimmers	\$25	\$35
16-25 swimmers	\$40	\$50
26-50 swimmers	\$65	\$75

- The pool hosts children's parties for members and non-members alike. If members are interested in renting the pool for an adult party, please reach out to us via email so we can discuss the details and determine pricing.
- If a non-member wants to host an adult party, they must be sponsored by a member, and for that member to be the main contact in arranging the details. The sponsoring member does not have to attend the party, but must sign the pool wavier.
- An additional \$25/ \$50 (M-Th/ Fri-Sun) fee is required for a non-member to rent the pool for a children's party. This fee may be higher for a sponsored adult party.
- All patrons using the pool pass the roped shallow end must be able to swim. We reserve the right to ask for a swim test for any swimmer to be allowed in the pool (treading water for two-minutes)
- All parties include swimming access, use of the deck and exclusive use of shelter. A propane grill is also provided for use. Outside food is allowed.
- 1/2 hour allotted for set-up and break-down for all parties.
- Parties may not be held during swim team practices or meets
- For children's parties, caregivers are not counted against attendant numbers if that caregiver does not intend to swim.
- All parties must be held during normal operating hours. The pool does not close to members during party rentals.
- For parties greater than 50 people, please email the pool to inquire about pricing.
- Any party to be found in excess of the agreed upon number will be assessed an additional charge of \$100 as this may present a safety concern and require immediate additional staffing.
- No glass is allowed. Drinks may not be served out of glass containers.
- Please notify the pool ahead of time if alcohol will be consumed. OPK reserves the right to limit what type of alcohol may be consumed on pool property. Consumption of undiluted hard liquor is prohibited.
- Underage drinking and illegal narcotics are strictly prohibited. Law enforcement will be call for anyone found violating this policy while on pool grounds.

- Large pool floats are not allowed as they may restrict lifeguard's view. Pool noodles are allowed.
- OPK reserves the right to ask any person to leave if found to be acting inappropriate, acting unsafely or intoxicated.
- Music is allowed but must be kept to a reasonable volume as to not disturb other guests and members. Music containing explicit language or profanity is prohibited. The hiring of a DJ for an outside party is not allowed.
