

OAK PARK POOL

Party Rental Pricing and Policy (*revised June 2018*)

Prices reflect a 2-hr. Party. 50% deposit is required to reserve the date.

Child Parties (majority of swimmers < 18 years-of-age)

Attendants	Weekday	Weekend
15 or less swimmers	\$50	\$75
16-25 swimmers	\$75	\$100
26-50 swimmers	\$100	\$125
Additional Hours	Add \$30 per hour	Add \$40 per hour

Adult Parties (majority of guests \geq 18 years-of-age)

Attendants	Weekday	Weekend
15 or less people	\$100	\$125
16-25 people	\$125	\$150
26-50 people	\$150	\$175
Additional Hours	Add \$60 per hour	Add \$80 per hour

- All parties include swimming access, use of the deck and exclusive use of shelter. A propane grill is also provided for use. Outside food is allowed.
- 1 hour allotted for set-up and break-down for all parties.
- For children's parties, caregivers are not counted against attendant numbers if that caregiver does not intend to swim.
- All parties must be held during normal operating hours.
- The pool does not close to members during party rentals.
- Non-Members may rent the pool for an additional \$50 for child party and \$100 for adult party.
- For parties greater than 50 people, please email the pool to inquire about pricing.
- Any party to be found in excess of the agreed upon number will be assessed an additional charge of \$100 as this may present a safety concern and require immediate additional staffing.
- No glass is allowed. Drinks may not be served out of glass containers.
- Please notify the pool ahead of time if alcohol will be consumed. OPK reserves the right to limit what type of alcohol may be consumed on pool property. Consumption of undiluted hard liquor is prohibited.
- Underage drinking and illegal narcotics are strictly prohibited. Law enforcement will be call for anyone found violating this policy while on pool grounds.
- Large pool floats are not allowed as they may restrict lifeguard's view. Pool noodles are allowed.
- OPK reserves the right to ask any person to leave if found to be acting inappropriate, acting unsafely or intoxicated.
- Music is allowed but must be kept to a reasonable volume as to not disturb other guests and members. Music containing explicit language or profanity is prohibited.
